- Identify start and end of a sentence.



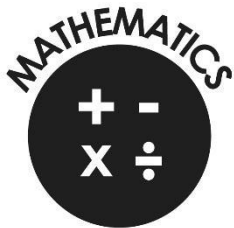
Writing

- Write simple sentences which can be read by themselves & others.
- Use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences.
- Write demarcated sentences.
- Use correct pencil grip.
- Write name (correct upper & lower case).
- Use correct letter formation for familiar words.



Mathematics

- Count reliably to 20.
- Order numbers 1 – 20.
- Say 1 more/1 less to 20.
- Add & subtract two single digit numbers.
- Count on/back to find the answer.
- Begin to solve problems that involve doubling and halving.
- Recognise 2d shapes and some common 3d shapes.
- Talk about and compare the different length, weight and capacity of objects.
- Continue a repeated pattern.
